I just received correspondence from Charles Elliott, Chair of the MERC Executive Council, concerning SRIG and MENC involvement with the Utah Symposium to be held on June 14-18, 1989 at the University of Utah. MENC has agreed to sponsor this symposium and proposes the following plan to all SRIGs:

- 1. That the SRIGs hold their business meetings at the bi-yearly research meetings rather than at the National Convention. Elections may be held at the Convention meetings but for the most part nominations, newsletter discussions, research activity discussions, etc. should be handled at the off-year research meeting.
- 2. That the meetings at the MENC National Convention be oriented toward practitioners. That topics and formats for these meetings be directed toward "bridging the gap" between research and practice. This may be the opportunity that we have waited for -- an effective way to disseminate research to the field with efficiency and dispatch.
